



## Smoking at Terminal Points

The company has been notified by Council Environmental Wardens of breaches of the law with regard to smoking and disposal of cigarette ends.

Please be reminded that if you wish to smoke whilst on a layover at a terminus, you must leave the bus and stand outside. In doing so please ensure you do not inconvenience any intending customers. You should also be aware that standing in the doorway of a bus is classified as an offence. Used cigarette ends must not be discarded on the ground and should be placed in a suitable waste bin.

Failure to do so will result in Environmental Wardens issuing offenders with a fixed penalty fine of £80.
