There is a 10mph speed limit at all times on Lothian property.

Please use designated walkways and report to the Traffic Office. You will be requested to sign in and you will be issued with a visitor pass of which you are required to show visibly at all times - please read the guidance contained on your pass carefully. On departure from Marine Garage, please remember to sign out and return your pass.
