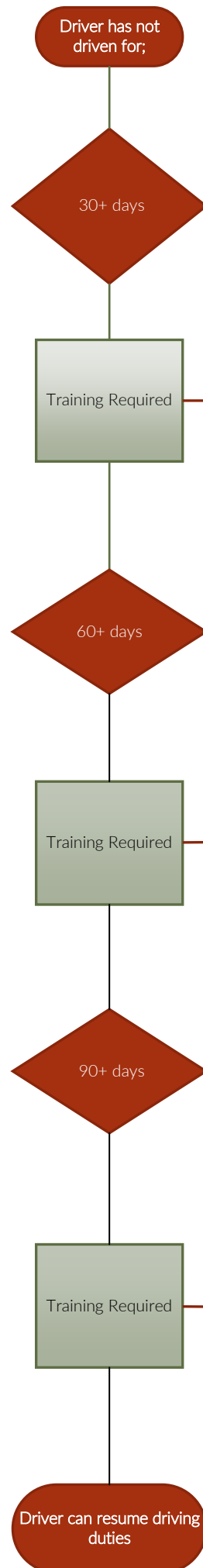


Note: Not every non regular driver will require training at the training school. The level of support to ensure competency will be assessed on a case by case basis.

Training duration is a guide and will be dependant on the individuals level of Competence;
1. Skills – How long has the individual held their PCV licence?
2. Experience – Driving different vehicle types and environment
3. Knowledge – Lothian Bus routes, diversions and hazards are up to date, if not where to find the required information.



Cannot Drive Until;

1. Driving skills are to a competent level.
2. Driver competence has been assessed, using DVSA - DL25 assessment form. *(Any serious/ dangerous outcomes will require additional training)*
3. Driver is aware of any significant changes that impacts their role as a driver, such as ~ polices ~ routes ~ traffic notices.
4. Driver has completed refresher training this will be dependant on the individuals – Confidence, ability, experience and route knowledge, the refresher training will be approximately 2 hours in duration and comprise of driving a training bus or being accompanied driving a service bus while on duty.

Cannot Drive Until;

1. Driving skills are to a competent level.
2. Driver competence has been assessed, using DVSA - DL25 assessment form. *(Any serious/ dangerous outcomes will require additional training)*
3. Driver is aware of any significant changes that impacts their role as a driver, such as ~ polices ~ routes ~ traffic notices.
4. Driver has completed refresher training this will be dependant on the individuals – Confidence, ability, experience and route knowledge, the refresher training will be approximately 4 hours in duration and comprise of driving a training bus within city centre environment

Cannot Drive Until;

1. Driving skills are to a competent level.
2. Driver competence has been assessed, using DVSA - DL25 assessment form. *(Any serious/ dangerous outcomes will require additional training)*
3. Driver is aware of any significant changes that impacts their role as a driver, such as ~ polices ~ routes ~ traffic notices.
4. Driver has completed refresher training this will be dependant on the individuals – Confidence, ability, experience and route knowledge, the refresher training will be approximately 8 hours in duration and comprise of driving a training bus within city centre environment.

Note: Training can only assess Drivers ability to drive the bus competently against Lothian competence standards
